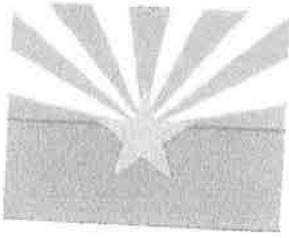
Action/Solution that needs to be instituted by employee:

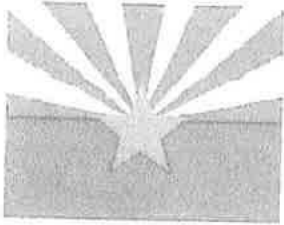
I received a call from Cesar around 22:50 telling me that he was pulled over on the shoulder of I-10 East where it meets the I-17. He said that he noticed sparks & smoke coming from the driver side rear axle of UDA Tanker 437. I immediately called the yardman on duty (Buddy) to see how UDA wanted to proceed with the matter. Buddy said he'd get in contact with Travis. About 10-15 min. later Cesar called me & said he was on Priest & not far from Alameda. He said he "limped" the truck in & should be able to drop it @ UDA. I called Buddy back to inform him. Shortly after Buddy called me telling me that the Duals were missing off of the tanker & that he was rolling up & down Priest looking for them but couldn't find them. I hopped in the Dodge & went looking for them & shortly after found them sitting at the bus stop on their side. They had knocked the seat off of one of the benches. After talking to Susan, Buddy & I managed to get the duals onto the bed of the Dodge & dropped off @ Alameda. Cesar was then taken down for a Rapid Drug Test.



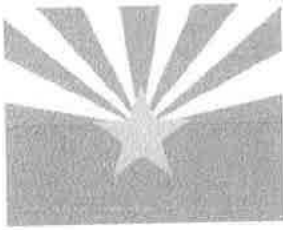

Cesar needs to eliminate all distractions while driving. Cesar needs to be aware that if caught doing this action of driving while on his cell phone it will result in termination.

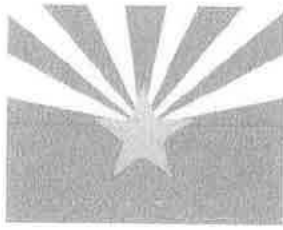



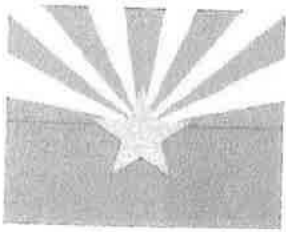
