#### Narrative:

Dispatched for Traumatic Injuries. Chief 29 en route advised that patient was trapped under a piece of railroad equipment. Chief 29 requested Rescue 37 to be added. Chief on board utility. Was advised to use access road south of incident past railroad bridge to access scene. AOS to find railroad maintenance crew working to rescue patient. Observed patient pinned under railroad equipment (see picture attached - equipment on left). Patient was in 'ball' face down between railroad tracks under equipment, Railroad crew stated that patient was under equipment for at least 15 minutes and unknown whether he was breathing. Patient was not moving or making any sounds. Railroad crew was using crane (on right side of attached picture) to lift equipment off of patient. Within approx 1 minute of my arrival, equipment had been lifted and maintenance crew pulled patient from under equipment south until patient cleared equipment. EMS 24 and EMS chief 13 had arrived on scene and began CPR.

Fire Police advised to shut down S River Road at Mountain Road and Brubaker road.

Engine 29-1 aos and i advised to park on South River Road in area of incident and place ladder over guard rail to access. Crew assisted with providing CPR. R37 aos and placed in service. Medic Stilo arrived, assessed and called for signal 12. Observed patient had head wounds, left leg wound in area of ankle.

PSP asked roadway keep closed for investigation. U 29-1 and FP 29 closed road and detoured traffic to Mountain Road from South and Brubaker Road from North. U 29 driven by FF Gros reassigned to assist with traffic control at intersection of Mountain Road/Brubaker Road.

Units from EMS 24, Lifeteam, EMS 13, R37, PSP, OSHA and Federal Railroad Admin on scene. No incidents to report.
