On or about 06/25/2019 at approximately 1:30 PM, SA Soojian reported to my office and requested the driver qualification and drug and alcohol testing files for driver Vlodymyer Shukouskyy.

SA Soojian: Mr. Galustov, why is it that Vlodoymyr Shukouskyy is no longer employed by your company.

- MC Mr. Shukouskyy was involved in an accident in Texas on June 3, 2019. I sent him to have a post-accident drug test and then I never heard from him until he came back to Massachusetts. Mr. Shukouskyy failed to do the post-accident drug and alcohol tests as I ordered until he return to MA on 06/07/2019. MC
- M G Mr. Shukouskyy had some reported damages to vehicles he had transported over the past few months so I decided that I could no longer have him as a driver in my company. His last day was June 7, 2019. However, he had not driven for my company after the accident on June 3, 2019 M G
