## 2 DAILY ACTIVITIES

- 0000 Operations continue from April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023  
The list continues to increase when pumps are not active; pumping efforts continue to be able to correct for list. Range remains 11°-14° to port
- 0015 Dive operations are complete, MSRC opens containment for dive vessel transit. Sea chests, keel coolers, shaft and stern tube were located and inspected with no pressure differential or ingress found during the survey. No visible hull damage was noted during the dive survey.
- 0020 With the dive team clear, the fire boat continues to focus cooling efforts on a hot spot near the bow
- 0810 A light sheen is reported inside the boom
- 1001 A potential source of sheen is located on starboard side deck crane with compromised hydraulic lines
- 1111 WA Dept of Ecology on site taking water samples inside boom
- 1120 Fire team on board for reconnaissance in engine room
- 1150 Fire team exits the engine room
- 1600 New mooring lines are established on the bow
- 1615 Active cooling continues on deck in the bow
- 1650 The fire team enters the vessel to fight fire in the bow
- 1730 Fire team exits the vessel
- 1830 Crew conducts Safety meeting for shift change
- 1915 One Tacoma Fire crew is relieved, due to no expectation of fire suppression efforts overnight
- 1930 Night crew continues dewatering and vac truck loading throughout the shift – a total of 49 vac truckloads of waste water to date
- 2359 Operations continue to April 12, 2023

- **Freon** - Today crew was able to access the refrigeration machinery space and confirm that the system is no longer a closed loop and that the tanks no longer contain amounts of freon beyond residual.
