2 DAILY ACTIVITIES

0000 Operations continue from April 13, 2023
0600 Shift Change and Safety Meeting
0730 Firefighting teams board the vessel to remove factory deck doors and begin installing ventilation systems. All areas of the vessel will be surveyed with Thermal Imaging Cameras before the fire is declared distinguished by the Salvage Master and Tacoma Fire Chief.
0800 An updated Dive Safety Plan is submitted to the Unified Command to cover the day's activities.
1130 Diver enters the water to conduct a hull survey in an attempt to locate a source of ingress of water in the engine room. After a thorough survey by the dive team, the Naval Architects determine that the source is likely a damaged ballast tank.
1400 Dive survey is complete.
1600 Fire is declared extinguished by the Salvage Master and Tacoma Fire Chief.
1630 Revision 2 of the Salvage Plan is submitted to SERT and the Unified Command.
1700 Installation of the ventilation system is complete and operational.
2359 Operations continue into April 15, 2023.

- Continue dewatering and vessel stabilization efforts
- Continue to revise Salvage Plan to incorporate dewatering and fuel lightering plans.
- Continue to monitor vessel stability
- Ventilate to create a safe workspace

- Freon - The crew was able to access the refrigeration machinery space and confirm that the system is no longer a closed loop and that the tanks no longer contain amounts of freon beyond residual.

7.1 SAFETY OBSERVATIONS

- A Site-Specific Health and Safety Plan was submitted to the Unified Command for approval.
- An updated Dive Operations Plan was submitted to the Unified Command for today's dive.
- Fatigue management is an important topic on-site at this stage, including awareness of signs of fatigue in co-workers.
