Office of Aviation Safety Central Region Memorandum for the Record Landing Gear Functionality Findings CEN22LA083 Houston, Texas

- After recovery, the airplane was moved to a hangar and the landing gear system was tested for functionality by the operator and FAA.
- The pilot did not recall if he saw a gear safe light illuminated after he completed a GUMPS check before landing.
- The airplane was lifted on airbags and the landing gear extended using the emergency extension procedure.
- Retraction and extension of the landing gear functioned in the normal mode.
- The cockpit gear-safe indicator light functioned normally when electrical power while the airplane was sitting on its extended gear in a hangar.

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
