Narrative:

The below information was provided by the Federal Aviation Administration. The requested information was a "Blue Ribbon" airman package for the accident pilot. The following details are excerpts from the report.

On May 24, 2019, the pilot was issued a Notice of Disapproval of Application for the Private Pilot Instrument Airplane rating. The aircraft used was a C-182 and the practical test was failed. The following tasks were noted as areas to be reexamined:

VII. Emergency Operations.

Comments: Distracted, loss of situational awareness and improper task management during partial panel operations. Requires partial panel nonprecision and a precision approach to complete.

On June 6, 2019, the pilot was issued a Notice of Disapproval of Application for the Private Pilot Instrument Airplane rating. The aircraft used was a C-182 and the practical test was failed. The following tasks were noted as areas to be reexamined:

VI. Instrument Approach Procedures

Comments: Full scale deflection on glideslope during ILS approach.

On June 27, 2019, the pilot was issued a temporary airman certificate with airplane instrument rating privileges.

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
