# CHECKLIST FOR REGISTERING/TITLING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN NEW YORK STATE

**Want to avoid the line?**

You can renew or replace your registration online.

**Want to speed your way through the office?**

Use this checklist to make sure you have everything you need to register your vehicle or receive a New York State title in your name. Additional information about these requirements can be found on form MV-82.1 (Registering/Titling a Vehicle in New York State).

## For all transactions, you will need:

- Proof of name and date of birth. A New York State document with photo meets this requirement. If you do not have a New York State document with photo, or you are a corporation or other entity, see form ID-82 (Proofs of Identity for Registration and Title) for other acceptable documentation.
- Payment of the fee. The fee can be paid with cash, a check or money order or credit card. The credit card holder must be present for the transaction. NOTE: The DMV cannot accept payment split between different payment methods.

## Requirements for specific transactions are listed below.

### To register/title a vehicle for the first time:

- Proof of Ownership. A certificate of title or transferable registration signed over to you
- Odometer Disclosure Statement OR Damage Disclosure Statement. If your title does not contain either an odometer statement (required for vehicles 10 years old or newer) or damage disclosure statement (required for vehicles 8 years old or newer), you must complete form MV-103 (Odometer and Damage Disclosure Statement).
- Completed sales tax form (DTF-802, DTF-803 or DTF-804). Forms are available from the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance website at <https://www.tax.ny.gov/forms/default.htm>
- Bill of Sale (you can use form MV-912 [Vehicle Bill of Sale] available from the DMV website)
- Lien Release (if applicable)
- New York State Insurance Card

### To change a registration/title:

- Proof of Ownership. (Original title or other proof of ownership)
- Proof of the change.

### To replace lost or damaged registration plates:

- If one plate is missing, bring in the remaining plate.
- If your vehicle plates are missing because of a crime, provide a completed MV-78B (Report of Lost, Stolen or Confiscated Motor Vehicle Items) or letter from a police agency to replace your vehicle plates free of charge

### To transfer plates to a different vehicle:

- Proof of ownership. A certificate of title or transferable registration signed over to you.  
**NOTE:** This applies to you if the proof of ownership is currently in your name OR the current owner provided authorization using form MV-95 (Registration Authorization and Co-Registrant Information)
- Existing Registration
- New York State Insurance Card

### To apply for a title only:

- Proof of ownership (a certificate of title or transferable registration signed over to you).
- Bill of Sale (you can use form MV-912 [Vehicle Bill of Sale] available from the DMV website)
- Completed sales tax form (DTF-802, DTF-803 or DTF-804). Forms are available from the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance website at <https://www.tax.ny.gov/forms/default.htm>

- Manufactured Homes
