The NTSB investigative team will review all factual comments and provide the parties with a written summary of the disposition of those comments, including whether changes have been or will not be made to the report and/or attachments.

The purpose of the technical review is to verify the accuracy and completeness of the factual information on which our analysis will be based. We are inviting factual comments only, not analytical comments or editorial suggestions.

After the technical review, you will have an opportunity to submit a party submission in which you may offer your analysis, including proposed conclusions, probable cause, and recommendations. Should you desire information on this process, including the deadlines for submission, it will be sent to you at a later date.

Please remember that draft factual reports and attachments are for official-use-only until released in the public docket, and NTSB regulations prohibit the release of investigative information that has not been released by the NTSB without prior consultation and approval of the IIC.
