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Dear Gordon, Paula, and Eric,

Here is the fuel receipt for 321PF prior to the flight to KCDC.

The instructor that helped get the aircraft out of the hangar said that he noticed the fuel onboard was 1/3 full on each side, so about 6 or 7 gallons per side (calculates to about 84 lbs of fuel) before he fueled and left from KSPK. It appears that he “topped” off the tanks prior to taking off as the receipt shows a total of 26.756 gallons.
