<p>On 5/5/2020 at approximately 1237 hours, I received a report of a possible plane crash near the Little Falls Airport. I responded to the airport and located an ultralight airplane that had appeared to have crashed. I made contact with the pilot, Michael Waytashek, who advised he had been attempting to take off in the aircraft when he got caught in the wind and crashed. Waytashek had a small cut to his eye but declined any medical attention. The airport manager was on scene and the aircraft was taken back to Waytashek's hangar.</p>	

Airport manager advised he would handle the notification to the FAA; however he was unsure if an ultralight aircraft was under their guidelines as there is no certification needed to fly one.

I took pictures of the aircraft and also obtained a statement from Waytashek and they will be added to the case file.

I left a voicemail on the reporting party's phone to advise of my findings. ■ Lange
