Deck Barge Burnside II

On or about 27 April 2023, the subject vessel was moored at Mosaic Dock, right descending bank. It was reported that the Cargo ship "Sirocco" broke away from Convent Marine Terminals, making contact with the Hopper Barge "MEM 5087," and subsequently pushing the Crane Rig "Glenn S" into the Deck Barge "Burnside II" and consequently into the Mosaic Dock.

History

On or about 27 March 2023, a Cargo ship "Sirocco" reportedly broke free from her mooring at Convent Marine Terminal and fell downriver before making contact with the Flotilla of barges moored to the Mosaic Dock near Convent, Louisiana. The ship drifted downriver and made contact with the Hopper Barge "MEM 5087," which was the outboard vessel moored to the Crane Rig "Glenn S," which, in turn, was moored to the "Burnside II," which was moored to the Mosaic Dock.

General Particulars of Vessel

The subject vessel is a Single skin, flush deck barge, of all welded steel construction, measuring 195' x 35' x 9', and consisting of Raked Bow, square stern, divided by a centerline bulkhead and six (6) transverse bulkheads dividing the vessel into a bow void, stern void and ten (10) midbody voids, five (5) each Port and Starboard.

She is fitted with an excavator aft, Hopper and conveyor system, and a mooring winch system. She is additionally fitted with three (3) storage containers, fuel tanks and a generator, forward.

Regarding the "Burnside II" -

Starboard Bow -Bumper set-in 0-2" Replace 8' x 12" two bolt, cut rubber bumper. Number 1 Starboard -Crop and renew VOBC, 10" channel x 6'-Truss 5, VOBC, distorted and part crushed 07", angle side longitudinals 1 and 4 as at angle side longitudinal no. 1 and 4, angle original, angle 5 x 3" x 2' side longitudinals affected in way. Number 3 Starboard -Truss 4, VOBC, distorted and part crushed Crop and renew VOBC as original, 10" x 0-3" 6'-07" One cut rubber bumper inset 0-2" Crop and renew bumper as original One piece formed rub-rail, inset, 0-2" x 2' Crop and renew formed rub-rail 12" x 2' Number 4 Starboard -Truss 4, VOBC, distorted and part-crushed Crop and renew VOBC as original 10" x 6'-0-2", angle side longitudinal number 4 07", angle side longitudinal in way, 5" x 3" affected in way x 2′
