Narrative:

During a telephone conversation, the trooper reported that the aircraft occupant had departed Perryville Regional Airport, Perryville, Missouri, just prior to the accident. The occupant, who did not hold a pilot certificate, was reportedly flying around his girlfriend's residence before crashing into the terrain. There were no witnesses to the accident.

After the accident, the occupant contacted his girlfriend to call 911. First responders on-scene had to shut down the operating airplane engine. The occupant was ejected from the airplane and sustained serious unknown injuries. The airplane sustained significant damage to the forward fuselage structure.

The occupant stated to the trooper, "I [REDACTED] ed up." No additional flight details were provided by the occupant to the trooper. The occupant was airlifted from the accident site.

The trooper was unable to locate any aircraft registration information.
