Narrative:

During a conversation with Robert Fitch, witness to the accident airplane, the following is a summary of what he stated:

- He recalled being on the phone when he looked up and observed the airplane.
- He verified the time at 1337 on his phone.
- The airplane was observed to be descending in a corkscrew about 45 degrees nose low, while it spiraled.
- The engine motor was running the entire time and it went to high rev and also sputtered.
- He observed a piece of white material fluttering in the air.
- He estimated the height of the airplane to be about 1000 feet.
- He was located in his home, which was under the ridgeline where the airplane impacted.
- The weather was good with no clouds or wind.
