ARRIVAL ANNOUNCEMENT C-06A

Prior to arrival

All crewmembers prepare for docking.

May I have your attention please – the ferry will be docking shortly.

For your safety all passengers are to remain off stairs, ramps and landings until the ferry has come to a complete stop at the terminal.

Remain behind the designated barriers for docking. Failure to do so could result in serious injury.

Please check and ensure you have all your personal belongings with you as you leave the ferry.

At no time are you allowed to leave any personal belongings unattended on the ferry.

DEPARTURE ANNOUNCEMENT C-06B

Prior to Departure

Good *[morning/afternoon/evening]* and welcome aboard the Staten Island Ferry _____.

This ferry is preparing to depart for the *[scheduled trip time]* trip. Please take a moment and pay attention to the following safety announcements.

If you are in need of assistance, please contact one of the crew members that are on station while the ferry is in operation.

Please familiarize yourself with placards containing crew member station locations and other safety related information posted throughout the ferry.

Stay off all stairways and landings while the ferry is approaching the terminal and docking.

There are lifejacket storage areas as well as donning instructions plainly posted and located throughout the ferry in case their use is required.

In case of an emergency, you will receive instructions over the public address system or by crew members directing your actions.

At no time are you allowed to leave any personal belongings unattended on the ferry.
