Fires Onboard

PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to describe the steps to take in the event of a fire onboard a vessel.

RESPONSIBILITY

- The Safety Manager owns this procedure and stewards its effectiveness to management.
- The Vessel Master is responsible for ensuring crewmembers adhere to this procedure.
- Crewmembers are responsible for adhering to this procedure.

TRAINING-DRILLS

- Initial training shall take place in Deckhand Training Course and new hire orientation.
- Monthly refresher training shall take place through Fire Drills.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Crewmembers that discover a fire shall notify the Wheelman on watch of fire and location.
- 2. Wheelman on watch:
 - a. Sound General alarm (continuous ringing of no less than 10 seconds supplemented by sounding of the whistle for a period of no less than 10 seconds)
 - b. Announce "<u>FIRE</u>", location, and class of fire over PA.
 - c. Retrieve life jacket.
 - d. Assess the degree of emergency to determine if the fire can be safely extinguished by crew.
 - e. Maneuver the vessel if possible upwind to take the flames and the smoke away from the vessel.
 - f. Maneuver the vessel to a safe location if possible.
 - g. Command all operations.
- 3. Wheelman off watch:
 - a. Report to the Pilothouse with life jacket.
 - b. Assist the Wheelman on watch.
 - c. Take over command if necessary.
- 4. Crewmember on watch:
 - a. Report to Muster Station with life jacket and VHF radio.
 - b. Establish communication with Wheelman on watch.
 - c. Lead the Emergency Team.
 - d. Extinguish fire if possible.
 - e. Man fire station.
- 5. Crewmember off watch:
 - a. Respond to General Alarm.
 - b. Report to Muster Station with life jacket.
 - c. Assist Emergency Team leader.
 - d. Assume Emergency Team lead if necessary.
- 6. Visitor:
 - a. Report to pilothouse with life jacket.
 - b. Stand by for instruction.

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- 7. Secure ventilation and power to affected fire area.
- 8. Utilize the proper extinguishing agent for the class of fire.
- 9. 2 crewmembers should be used to fight a fire.
- 10. At least 1 crewmember shall remain at the site of the fire with proper extinguishing equipment on watch for re-flash.
- 11. If water is used to extinguish a fire, you shall initiate steps for de-watering by any means possible.

Wheelman makes appropriate calls to Coast Guard, VTS, any traffic in the area and office.

When calling office state "I HAVE A VESSEL EMERGENCY! PLEASE ASK THE PORT CAPTAIN ON CALL TO CONTACT ME IMMEDIATELY" THIS IS THE MOTOR VESSEL (state the name of your vessel and give your contact number). Follow steps as outlined in <u>SMS-10-01 Incident/Accident Reporting</u>.
