Some of Oxy's cars were on the train and I know that all hazmat notification processes have already kicked off with NS and Chemtrec using the emergency number listed on the waybills. But, we still wanted to reach out and let you know about it in case you were not otherwise aware. We'd rather overcommunicate in this situation.

There were about 52 cars involved, and these are five on the list that Oxy as the shipper.

Emergency responders have been on site and NS crews are working around the clock to
