Hello.

I live at ward and noticed a plane flying very low and very slow. We regularly see vintage aircraft flying over from the various general aviation airports in the area. I thought this was another vintage craft as it was very loud and not running very smoothly. As it flew directly over, I was somewhat anxious and thought to myself this is very low and should not be over residential areas and could possibly be in trouble. The plane continued on a north to northeasterly track but the plane was oriented such that the nose was about 30 degrees right of the direction of travel. It appeared to maintain a consistent altitude and direction. Later in the day I saw the local news report. I don't know the exact time but it was around noon which corresponded with the info in the news report so I know it had to be the same plane, twin engine propeller, blue and white.
