Mr. Calloway stated he was working on his back deck when he heard an airplane's engine about 0900. The airplane came from the west and was heading east at a fast rate. "I could tell first off that it was a very small aircraft. I could see the right-wing tip down and then roll to inverted". He stated it rolled quickly and was very fast. He continued to watch as the airplane departed to the east.

Mr. Hallyburton stated he was walking from a back building on his property when he heard what was thought to be a radio-controlled airplane about 0910. He could see the airplane is a straight-line flight path down. He stated hearing loud engine noises that changed pitch, "the wings didn't change position and I could see the wheels". The airplane fell below the tree line and did not reappear. Later that day he heard about an airplane crash in the neighborhood.
