To further develop the student's competence in cross-country solo operations through the planning and flying of a solo two hour day cross-country flight. This flight must be greater than 100 NM, with landings at a minimum of three points, and one segment of the flight consisting of a straight line distance greater than 50 NM between takeoff and landing locations. Soft and short field takeoffs and landings will not be practiced solo.
