Here's what I got back from Mike. Doesn't look like a lot has changed...

There has been no change with the Alaska A-Paid station at Rainy Pass. It is still a manual observing station with only five observations taken daily, during daylight hours. I'm not sure when this accident happened so I'm unable to determine if observations were taken around the time of the accident.

We did transition the Skwentna A-Paid station to an automated station last August, but that is the only station that has been converted in recent years.
