## [E] - EXTERNAL SENDER

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Good Afternoon Jena,

Sorry for the delay in getting back to you. SkyGuard Flash Flood Warnings are sent to CSX when 3 inches of rain is expected in 3 hours or less. There are areas throughout CSX's tracknetwork that CSX provided AccuWeather as know flash flood prone areas. In these flash flood prone areas, lesser amounts of rain can trigger a flash flood warning. Below is a list of all the SkyGuard Warning criteria.

# SkyGuard Warning Criteria:

- Tornadoes within 3 miles of track
- Winds 55 mph or more on most of the track
- Sustained Winds of 35 mph or more in areas where CSX operates lift bridges (59 total bridges)
- Flash flooding, 3" in 3 hours or less
- Snow 2 inches or more across entire track network (changed 12/13/2010)
- Any Accumulating Ice
- Cold Temperature Warning of Zero degree or colder temperatures expected to last for 4+ hours
- Cold Temperature Alert of 10 degrees or colder temperatures expected to last for 8+ hours
- High Temperature Warning of 90 degrees or higher temperatures expected to last 4+ hours
- Temperature Change 30 degrees F in 3 hours or less (regardless of temperatures).
- Earthquakes of 5.0-5.4 within 30 miles of track, earthquakes of 5.5-5.9 within 50 miles, earthquakes of 6.0-6.9 within 100 miles, and earthquakes of 7.0 or greater within 150 miles.
- Tornado Watches
- Severe Thunderstorm Watches
