

Miscellaneous Dispatcher Messages, Continued

Overview of rules and procedures for, Heat and/or Flood Warnings, High Wind and Signal Suspension

The Miscellaneous Dispatcher Message Menu utilizes special formatting of certain dispatcher messages.

Messages concerning Heat and/or Flood Warnings will be issued upon the request of engineering department personnel, and must not be removed until the engineering department requests that they be removed.

- Heat Warning (Form H) (entire subdivision or part of a subdivision)
- Flash Flood Warning (Form F) (entire subdivision or part of a subdivision)

NOTE: Additional verbiage can be added to those special dispatcher messages with the additional lines in the body.

In the event that a signal system is rendered inoperative by storm, flood, or other cause and prompt restoration cannot be accomplished, or construction work necessitates the signals to be temporarily removed from service, an alternate method of operation must be established.
