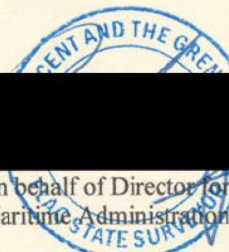
1. That the ship has been surveyed in accordance with the requirements of Regulation I/10 of the Convention.
