As the duty officer for Pacific fire on the assist to Boles, I was assigned as the officer in charge for the extrication of the victim in the pick-up truck. The truck was sitting on the frame and fifth wheel area of a road tractor with no trailer attached. The truck was folded up in the shape of a u and had a school bus sitting on top it. One victim was located in the cab area of the truck, which was upside down behind the rear axle of the truck. With the assistance of the towing co. the pick-up was secured to the road tractor with chains so it would not move when the bus was removed from on top of it. After the bus was removed the removal of the victim was started. The only thing visible of the victim was a boot and lower leg partially out of the side of the vehicle. The driver side door and crew cab door were stuck together and partially removed; this was removed first by hydraulic tools. Access was then gained by using hydraulic rams, and cutters to open up the passenger area of the pick-up. The victim was found laying face down in the roof area of the vehicle facing the passenger side. The victim was then removed by Meramec ambulance personnel and placed into the body bag. Crews removed the equipment from the vehicle and Pacific units were released shortly thereafter.
