On 10-08-2011 at about 1451 hrs I was notified by Brooks County 911 that a small plane carrying two passengers had possibly crashed in Brooks County. Brooks County 911 informed me that they had received a phone call from the pilot of the plane and he had stated he took off from Thomas County and started heading north when he experienced some engine problems and then crashed somewhere in Brooks County 4 miles north of Madison Florida. I then contacted Lieutenant Bell of the Brooks County Sheriff's Office and he stated that he would go to the 911 center and try to locate the plane by using the cell phone the pilot was using or by the planes transponder. I then got word from Lieutenant Bell that the plane was approximately 2.1 miles east of the Dixie-Barwick cell tower that is located in Dixie Ga. behind Boston Tractor Company. I then met with Captain Miller of the Brooks County Sheriff's Office along with the Sheriff Mike Dewey and we began to search the area north of Hwy 84 between Dewberry Road and Dixie-Barwick Road. At about 1634 hrs I then got word over the radio that a Thomas County unit that was assisting in the search for the plane had located it just south of the Dixie Road and the Dewberry-Short intersection. The plane was on the south side of the Dixie Road at the back of a hay field just into the tree line. When I arrived on scene Thomas County Rescue 1 was already on scene giving medical attention to the pilot (Larry Boiven) and the passenger (Jared Shilling) appeared to be DOA. Brooks County EMS arrived on scene at about 1636 hrs and continued to give medical attention to the pilot. They also checked the passenger and requested we contact the coroner. At this time the scene was secured by the Brooks County Sheriff's Office and the Sheriff notified the NTSB. The registration # on the plane was N41907 and the aircraft serial # is 1868. Pictures of the scene were taken by myself and Deputy Hesters of the Brooks County Sheriff's Office and the evidence at the scene was collected by Deputy Anglin of the Brooks County Sheriff's Office.
