

4" and 2" pipe sizes and wall thicknesses – Arliss St

1. 4" - 1962
 - a. Based on installation and accounting records along with stock codes from 1962, the 4" main on Arliss St is 4" STANDARD BLACK STEEL PIPE, BEVELED ENDS, WRAPPED LINE PIPE API-5L
2. 4" offset – 1969, 2" relocation from Piney Branch to Arliss St
 - a. Based on installation and accounting records along with stock codes from 1969, the 4" main on Arliss St is 4" STANDARD BLACK STEEL PIPE, BEVELED ENDS, WRAPPED LINE PIPE API-5L
 - b. Based on installation and accounting records along with stock codes from 1969, the 2" service on Arliss St is 2" STANDARD BLACK STEEL PIPE, BEVELED ENDS, WRAPPED LINE PIPE API-5L
3. 2" service – 1955
 - a. Based on installation records along with earliest known stock codes, the 2" main on Arliss St is 2" STANDARD BLACK STEEL PIPE, BEVELED ENDS, WRAPPED LINE PIPE API-5L
4. The table below outlines the specific diameters and wall thicknesses referenced above as defined by API 5L during those vintages:
